

Cookie Policy

What are cookies and similar technologies?

- Cookies are small text files that websites or services store in your browser or on your device when you visit them; during subsequent visits, they can be read by the same domain to recognize your browser, save settings, or perform technical functions.
- Similar technologies. In addition to cookies, pixels/tags, local storage, IndexedDB, SDKs in mobile applications, device identifiers, and fraud/bot prevention technologies may be used; for the purposes of this Policy, all of these are considered "cookies" unless otherwise specified.

Categories of cookies we use

- Strictly necessary cookies. Purpose: to ensure the basic functioning of the website/application and access to secure areas, routing, load balancing, session authentication, security (anti-bot/anti-CSRF), and saving cookie consent choices. In the EEA, prior consent is not usually required for strictly necessary cookies.
- Preferences (functionality) cookies. Purpose: to remember user choices and settings, such as interface language, region, design, workspace settings, or accessibility features, to provide a personalized experience without re-entering data on subsequent visits.
- Statistics (performance/analytics) cookies. Purpose: to measure interaction with the website/application (pages visited, clicks, time spent on the website, navigation paths), detect errors, and improve performance. May be set by our own means or by third-party analytics providers; in the EEA, prior consent is required for them unless they are strictly necessary.
- Marketing (targeting/advertising) cookies. Purpose: to create or use identifiers to display relevant advertising, frequency capping, measure campaign effectiveness, retargeting on external networks, and synchronize identifiers between advertising platforms; In the EEA, prior consent is required, and in California, "Do Not Sell/Share" rules may apply to cross-context behavioral advertising.

How to manage cookies

- Settings center. For non-essential categories, a granular consent mechanism is provided: "Accept All," "Reject Non-Essential," "Customize," as well as the ability to change your selection at any time in "Privacy/Cookie Settings"; non-essential tags/pixels are blocked until consent is given in jurisdictions where required.
- Browser/device settings. You can delete or block cookies through your browser or OS settings; this may affect the functionality that depends on cookies. The availability of options depends on the specific browser/platform.
- Opt-out signals. Where required by law, relevant signals such as Global Privacy Control (GPC) are respected; for California residents, the option "Do Not Sell/Share My Personal Information" is available for practices that may qualify as "sale" or "sharing."

Note regarding third parties

- Some cookies are set by third parties (analytics, advertising, payments, anti-fraud, chat widgets); these parties act as separate controllers for their processing and apply their own privacy policies. A complete list of providers, purposes, and retention periods is provided in the Cookies List table in this Policy or in the relevant appendix; the list may be updated periodically.

What type of cookies does Agent X Group LLC use?

- Preferences cookies (functionality). Used exclusively to remember selected interface settings (e.g., language, region, display) to optimize the presentation of information and avoid the need to reselect them on subsequent visits. Without these cookies, the site can still function, but the experience will be less personalized.
- Statistics cookies (analytics). A third-party service, Google Analytics, is used to understand how the website is used (pages visited, clicks, time on the site, navigation paths). Google Analytics uses its own identifiers and processes first-party cookies, device/browser information, IP address, and activity on the website/in the application to measure and report on user interactions. This data is provided to ARENT Group in the form of aggregated statistical reports that help improve the performance and usability of the website.

Consent and control

- EEA/UK/CH. In jurisdictions where required by law, statistical (non-strictly necessary) cookies are only set after explicit consent via a banner/preference center; consent can be changed at any time in "Cookie Settings." Preference cookies may also require consent depending on local law. How to opt out
- Preference cookies. To opt out of cookies that remember your language selection or other preferences, you can:
 - use "Cookie Settings" on the website to disable the relevant category; and/or
 - delete/block cookies in your browser settings, following the browser's help materials or general advice on managing cookies (external reference materials are available online).
- Google Analytics. To opt out of analytics:
 - disable the "Statistics/Analytics" category in "Cookie Settings" (where available); and/or
 - use the official Google Analytics opt-out tools (e.g., browser add-on or other optout mechanisms, if supported by your current browser/device). Notes
- After opting out, some personalization or audience measurement features may be unavailable or limited.
- The list of categories and purposes may be updated periodically; current settings and consent status are available in "Cookie Settings" in the footer of the website or in the "Privacy Center" section.
